Dear Chairman Goldner:

Enclosed please find the petition of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) for its default Energy Service (“ES”) rate proposed to begin on February 1, 2025. Consistent with the settlement agreement in Docket No. DE 17-113, and the Commission’s recent orders in this docket, Eversource has procured ES for 70% of its small customer group through a competitive solicitation process for the period of February 1, 2025 through July 31, 2025, with the remainder of the small customer group load and 100% of the large customer group load to be procured through direct participation in the ISO New England wholesale power markets.

The proposed fixed ES rate for the period of February 1, 2025 through July 31, 2025 for the small customer group is \$0.08929 per kWh (or 8.929¢ per kWh). This represents a 14.2% decrease in the ES rate from the current period rate of \$0.10403 per kWh. For the large customer group, the proposed monthly rates are as follows:

Accompanying this Petition are the pre-filed testimony and supporting materials of Luann J. Lamontagne, Parker Littlehale, Ashley N. Botelho, and Edward A. Davis, explaining the combined competitive RFP process used and direct market participation to be used by Eversource to procure ES supply, the results of the recent competitive solicitation, and the proxy price

determinations, rate adjustments, and reconciliations that have resulted in the retail rates proposed to be charged to Eversource's ES customers during the February-July 2025 rate period.

Consistent with N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 201.06 and 201.07, Eversource is seeking confidential treatment of information related to the RFP, including the specific RFP bids submitted, and related load forecast information. Because of this, a confidential, unredacted version of the filing, including confidential supporting live Excel worksheets, is being provided to the Commission, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, and the Department of Energy only, and is not to be made publicly available. A redacted, public version of the filing will be distributed to the service list and for posting to this docket.
