Enclosed please find the petition of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) for its competitively procured default Energy Service (“ES”) rate proposed to begin on August 1, 2024. Consistent with the settlement agreement in Docket No. DE 17-113, and Commission Order No. 26,994 issued in Docket No. DE 23-043, Eversource has procured ES supply for customers in both its small customer group and its large customer group for the period from August 1, 2024 through January 31, 2025 through a competitive solicitation, with the exception of a single 12.5% tranche of small customer group load that will be self-supplied through direct participation in the regional wholesale power markets.

Accompanying this Petition are the testimony and supporting materials of Parker Littlehale, Luann J. Lamontagne, Yi-An Chen, and Scott R. Anderson, explaining the competitive RFP process used by Eversource for procuring ES supply, the results of that solicitation, the market-based self-supply tranche of small customer group load, and the rate adjustments and prior period reconciliations, including in particular a recommended alternative approach to recovery of certain reconciliation balances, that have led to the retail rates proposed to be charged to Eversource’s ES customers.

Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 201.06 and 201.07, Eversource is seeking confidential treatment of certain information related to the RFP, including the specific RFP bids submitted, and related load forecast information. Because of this, a confidential, unredacted version of the filing, including confidential supporting live Excel worksheets, is being provided to the Commission, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, and the Department of Energy only, and is not to be made publicly available. A redacted, public version of the filing will be distributed to the service list and for posting to this docket.
