Dear Chairman Goldner:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty, and pursuant to the Commission’s Order No. 27,027, in this docket, issued on June 27, 2024, enclosed please find the following in response to the directives of the Commission regarding a proposal for an expanded ISO-New England market-based procurement approach and outlining the changes to Bad Debt allocation in its Energy Service filing:

- Technical Statement of Christopher M.D. Green
- Technical Statement of Robert Garcia and Adam R.M. Yusuf
  - Attachment 1 – Data Requests #1-5 and #1-7 from DOE Data Set 1 that support the Technical Statement of Robert Garcia and Adam R.M. Yusuf
  - Attachment 2 – Proposed Second Revised Page 25 of the Company’s Tariff, clean and redlined versions.

Note that the Garcia/Yusuf technical statement asks the Commission to approve tariff language changes to allow for the recovery of any hedging costs that the Company may incur. Liberty makes this request pursuant to Puc 1605, “Service or Tariff Change Other than a Full Rate Case. Specifically, Puc 1605.01(b) authorizes the Commission to approve tariff changes through a streamlined process so long as those changes do not result in a “significant change to the return on the cost of the property of the utility used and useful in the provision of services.” That process requires the filing of a cover letter, clean and redlined tariff pages, and a technical statement supporting the request. Puc 1605.02(2). Liberty has satisfied these requirements by this cover letter and the attached documents and respectfully asks the Commission to approve the proposed tariff changes.
