Re: Docket No. DE 24-065 Unitil Energy Systems, Inc.

Dear Chair Goldner:

On December 20, 2024, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (“Unitil” or “Company”) submitted revised Default Service rates and proposed tariffs for effect February 1, 2025 in compliance with the Commission’s Order No. 27,086. Included with that filing were proposed tariff page 74, Calculation of the Default Service Charge [Non-G1] and page 75, Calculation of the Default Service Charge [G1]. The Company indicated that two additional tariff pages would be impacted as a result of changes to the February 1, 2025 default service charges.¹ Specifically, the Company intended to file its Summary Of Whole House Residential Time Of Use Rates And Electric Vehicle Rates, tariff page 5-A, and Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts, tariff page 6, as part of a compliance filing to be made after the Commission’s final order approving the February 1-July 31, 2025 default service charges. Unitil reserved filing tariff pages 5-A and 6 as they were pending approval for effect January 1, 2025 in DE 24-113, Unitil’s System Benefits Charge (“SBC”).

As part of its December 20, 2024 filing, the Company provided Revised Schedule LSM-7 and Revised Schedule LSM-8, which support the figures shown on tariff pages 5-A and 6. Revised Schedule LSM-7 shows the application of time of use ratios to the pending default service rates, and Revised Schedule LSM-8 shows the application of the Low-Income Electric Assistance Program (LI-EAP) Discount percentages to the pending

default service rates. Since the Company's filing on December 20, 2024 in this docket, the Commission has approved tariff pages 5-A and 6 in DE 24-113.

Although the Commission has not issued a final order in this matter, in an effort to clarify the record, Unitil now presents the proposed tariff page 5-A, Summary Of Whole House Residential Time Of Use Rates And Electric Vehicle Rates, and page 6, Summary of Low-Income Electric Assistance Program Discounts tariff pages, for effect February 1, 2025, incorporating the pending default service rates as filed on December 20, 2024. Redline versions of tariff pages 5-A and 6 have also been included. As provided in the Company's initial filing in this docket, filed December 6, 2024, subsequent changes to tariff page 5-A would be required for effect June 1, 2025, reflecting approved default service charges and summer time of use ratios. It is the Company's intent to file this page in compliance with the Commission's order approving the currently pending default service charges.
