Dear Chair Goldner:

On December 12, 2024, the Commission issued Order No. 27,086 directing Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (“UES” or “Company”) to make a filing by January 31, 2025, to include (1) a proposal to expand its ISO-New England market-based procurement tranche for Small and Medium customer groups; (2) a proposal for a full (100 percent) ISO-New England market-base procurement for the Large (GI) Customer Group; and (3) a discussion of the additional resources that would be necessary for the application of a full Day-Ahead self-supply purchase component going forward by the Company. In compliance with that directive, the Company submits the enclosed the prefiled testimony of Jeffrey M. Pentz. Through the testimony of Mr. Pentz the Company presents the components listed above.

As indicated in the Technical Statement should the Commission direct the Company to implement the proposals, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission issue any such directive by **April 8, 2025** in order to give the Company enough time to make the necessary changes.
