I am writing as a consumer requesting that the PUC does not approve the requested 16.57% increase in distribution charges from Eversource.

The amount of my electric bill continues to increase yearly despite trying to control costs at home and switching suppliers. Even after switching suppliers Eversource's distribution charges amount to the same amount I am charged from the electricity provider, my bill is in effect doubled. We are an average household of 3 and the electric bill runs from 200-250 a month. This is unsustainable and will only get worse with climate change.
