Dear Chairman Goldner:

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued a Procedural Order on November 5, 2024 indicating a focus on capital investments, operation and maintenance expenses, and issues of rate design during the January 7th and 8th technical sessions. Subsequent discussions indicated review of depreciation as another topic for discussion at the upcoming technical sessions. On behalf of the New England Connectivity & Telecommunications Association ("NECTA"), I would like to request that the Commission list or reserve "poles" as a potential topic for discussion during the upcoming technical sessions not necessarily limited to their relation to the listed topics. I conferred with Eversource, and they are working to have appropriate staff available to answer this topic. However, if they are not available, the Company will make alternative arrangements to ensure NECTA's questions are answered.
