Request for Change in Distribution Rates

Procedural Order Re: Late-Filed Motions to Intervene, Related Waivers

The Commission takes note of the late-filed motions to intervene by AARP New Hampshire (AARP), filed on September 9, 2024, and by Mr. Aleksandar Milosavljevic-Cook, filed on September 13, 2024. (Pursuant to the original order of notice and commencement of adjudicative proceeding, Order No. 27,029, issued in this instant docket on June 28, 2024, petitions to intervene were due by July 12, 2024). AARP represents that it is an association with approximately 212,000 members in New Hampshire, many of whom are customers of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource). Mr. Milosavljevic-Cook represents that he is an Eversource customer resident in Sanbornville.

Having reviewed these late-filed petitions to intervene, the Commission has determined to WAIVE the July 12, 2024 deadline for intervention, and WAIVE the 10-day time frame for responses to these petitions under N.H. Code Admin. R. Puc 203.07(e), as such waiver serves the public interest, and will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission. N.H. Code Admin. R. Puc 201.05.


Furthermore, the Commission GRANTS the petitions for intervention by AARP and Mr. Milosavljevic-Cook, under RSA 541-A:32, II, and N.H. Code Admin. R. Puc 203.17, as their intervention would be in the interest of justice and their participation may assist in the Commission's investigation of the noticed issues in this proceeding. The Commission also

wishes to afford AARP and Mr. Milosavljevic-Cook the opportunity to participate in the consultations for Eversource's upcoming procedural schedule filing to be made on September 20, 2024. (However, the Commission does reserve the right to deny any future late-filed intervention petitions in this proceeding).
