I am writing to express my strong support for the petition currently under review to modify the franchise area between Eversource and New Hampshire Electric Cooperative (NHEC).

I am the owner of the property in question, located at 301 Allbee Road (lot 3-17), and I reside directly across the street at 324 Allbee Road, which is already served by NHEC. My family recently constructed a home on the 301 Allbee Road property for my elderly parents, who are eagerly waiting to move in. The only outstanding issue preventing their move is the connection to the power grid.

Approval of this petition is critical to ensuring that 301 Allbee Road can be served by NHEC, my current provider, which has existing poles much closer to the house than Eversource. Connecting to Eversource's infrastructure would not only be logistically challenging but also financially burdensome due to the significant distance between the property and their nearest power supply. Conversely, connecting to NHEC is far more practical and efficient given the proximity of their infrastructure and their established service to other properties in the area, including my current residence.

This modification would not only resolve this issue quickly but also support a logical alignment of service boundaries that minimizes unnecessary costs and delays.

I kindly urge the Commission to approve this petition as soon as possible to avoid further delays and to ensure my parents can transition comfortably and safely into their new home.
