Enclosed for filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) on behalf of Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource” or the “Company”), please find the Company’s Updated Petition requesting approval to adjust its Stranded Cost Recovery Charge (“SCRC”) for effect on February 1, 2025, pursuant to Puc 202.01(a) and Puc 203.06, the requirements of RSA 374-F:3 and RSA 369-B:3, the Agreement to Settle PSNH Restructuring (Revised and Conformed) in Docket No. DE 99-099 (“Restructuring Settlement”), the 2015 Public Service Company of New Hampshire Restructuring and Rate Stabilization Agreement in Docket No. DE 14-238 (the “2015 Agreement”), and Order No. 26,099 (January 30, 2018) in Docket No. DE 17-096. Consistent with Order No. 26,658 (July 28, 2022) and Order No. 26,768 (January 30, 2023), the SCRC is now adjusted on an annual basis, effective as of February 1 each year.

In support of the Updated Petition, Eversource encloses the updated supporting testimony and attachments of Ashley N. Botelho and Edward A. Davis. As stated in their updated joint testimony, Eversource is now proposing specific SCRC rates and separate adders for effect February 1<sup>st</sup>, including the new Energy Service Reconciliation Adder, as directed in the Commission’s June 20, 2024 order in the Energy Service docket, DE 24-046.

As also set forth in the enclosed updated joint testimony, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Updated Petition no later than January 27, 2025, to allow for rates to become effective on February 1, 2025.
