Procedural Order Re: Request for Positions on Procedure


Reference is made to the “Joint Motion for Rehearing of Orders in this Docket and For a Prehearing Conference,” filed in the instant Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) Stranded Cost Recovery Charge (SCRC) docket on January 13, 2025 by several intervenor parties¹ (Joint Motion).

In light of the various procedural requests presented in the Joint Motion, and their potential implications on the implementation of Eversource’s SCRC rate proposals for a February 1, 2025 effective date, and the Commission’s review of same, the Commission REQUESTS that Eversource, and the other parties to this proceeding, provide their positions to the Commission in filings made **no later than 4:30 p.m. on January 16, 2025**, regarding the following potential course of Commission action: (1) cancellation of the January 21, 2025 hearing in this SCRC proceeding; (2) scheduling of a prehearing conference regarding the Energy Service (ES) reconciliation-related SCRC proposals by Eversource for 9:00 a.m. on February 4, 2025; (3) having a March 19, 2025 all-day hearing on all of the issues noticed in this SCRC proceeding, including the ES reconciliation-related proposals; and (4) an extended April 1, 2025 implementation date for the SCRC

rates to be potentially approved in this instant proceeding. (The Company's currently-approved SCRC rates would remain in effect through March 31, 2025, pending the outcome of this extended proceeding and the April 1 implementation of the new SCRC rates, if this course of action were to be taken).
