
**Procedural Order Re: Procedural Schedule for Energy Service Reconciliation Issues**


The Commission refers to the filing made by most of the parties to this above-captioned proceeding, through the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE), on January 30, 2025, presenting an assented-to procedural schedule proposal for the Commission's consideration. (The position of the Retail Energy Supply Association regarding the proposal is not indicated in this filing). Having reviewed the proposal, the Commission hereby APPROVES the DOE-presented schedule for the Energy Service Rate Reconciliation Adjustment Factor phase of this proceeding, with one modification, as presented in RED below for the hearing date. (The Commission has other scheduling commitments in April that require a hearing in this matter to be scheduled for early May).
