## **Procedural Order Re: Record Requests**

The Commission requests that Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a

Eversource Energy (Eversource) respond to the following record requests on or before the

## close of business on Wednesday, February 8, 2023:

<u>RR-1</u>: Describe in detail the demand response programs in Connecticut and Massachusetts in which EV charging customers participate. The response should include:

- (i) a description of the specific types of financial and other incentives offered as part of the managed charging program in each jurisdiction;
- (ii) details on the number of customers by class participating in each of the respective programs;
- (iii) the results of any studies or reporting required in those states; and
- (iv) reference to dockets and orders authorizing the programs referred to above.

<u>RR-2</u>: Provide a description of whether Time-of-Use (TOU) rates are available or planned to be made available in other Eversource territories, including details on any associated timelines.

<u>RR-3</u>: In providing an overview of costs and manual system and billing changes associated with implementing TOU rates for its commercial-class customers, Eversource indicated in the hearing held on January 31, 2023, its preference for "other alternatives" to its proposed commercial TOU rates. The Commission requests that Eversource provide a detailed overview of these alternatives, along with any additional costs or system changes that may be necessary to apply those alternatives.
