2020 Annual Storm Fund Report

Procedural Order Re: Motion to Enlarge Time

The Commission issued a procedural order on December 1, 2021 in the above-captioned matter requiring the New Hampshire Department of Energy (Energy) and any interested parties to object to, or request additional time to investigate, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty's (Liberty) 2020 annual storm fund report by January 4, 2022. On January 5, 2022, Energy filed a motion, to which Liberty did not object, requesting additional time to complete its investigation and issue its report regarding the 2020 annual storm fund report. Energy stated that it anticipated its investigation would be completed by March 29, 2022, with a final report to be filed thereafter. In its motion, Energy also requested a waiver of its failure to file the motion prior to the expiration of the January 4, 2022 deadline.

Energy's request for a waiver and its motion have been GRANTED. See N.H. Admin. R., Puc 201.05 and Puc 202.04. Energy and any interested parties shall file their responses to Liberty's 2020 annual storm fund report by Thursday, May 5, 2022.
