Procedural Order Re: Motion to Cancel Rebuttal Testimony Deadline

On October 13, 2021, the Commission approved the parties' proposed procedural schedule, which included a May 17, 2022 deadline for filing rebuttal testimony, "if needed." Northern Utilities, Inc. (Northern)¹ filed a motion on May 12, 2022 to cancel the May 17 deadline without prejudice. In its motion, Northern stated that the parties had reached a comprehensive agreement in principle, which they were in the process of memorializing, so that rebuttal testimony would no longer be necessary. Northern noted that the other parties, the New Hampshire Department of Energy and the Office of the Consumer Advocate, assented to its motion.

Accordingly, Northern's motion to cancel the May 17 deadline for filing rebuttal testimony is GRANTED.
