### 2022 Regulatory Reconciliation Adjustment

#### Procedural Order Re: Request for Hybrid Hearing

The Commission scheduled an in-person hearing in this matter on June 23, 2022. On June 15, 2022, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) filed a late request for remote participation by one of its witnesses, Edward A. Davis. In its request, Eversource stated it recently discovered that Mr. Davis has a previous commitment in Upstate New York on the date of the hearing, so that requiring him to appear in New Hampshire in person would cause a substantial hardship. Eversource represented that the New Hampshire Department of Energy and the Office of the Consumer Advocate did not object to this request.

Eversource has provided good reason for Mr. Davis to appear remotely on June 23, 2022. Therefore, a hybrid hearing format will be used for the June 23 hearing to accommodate Mr. Davis only. Any other parties or witnesses wishing to appear remotely at the hearing are required to file a separate request.
