Company's revenue decoupling adjustment factor (RDAF). As this filing did not include a

petition or a specific request for relief, see N.H. Admin. R., Puc 202.01(a), it appeared to

have been made for informational purposes related to the other rate changes UES

intended to propose for effect on August 1, 2023, namely, those resulting from changes to

its stranded cost charge (SCC) and external delivery charge (EDC).

2023 rates, including those relating to the RDAF. Therefore, this filing shall be included in

Stranded Cost Recovery, and External Delivery Charge Reconciliation and Rate Filing."
