# COMMISSION MEETING

### November 29, 2022

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Meeting began at 1:37 p.m. on Tuesday, November 29, 2022. Commissioner Pradip Chattopadhyay and Commissioner Carleton Simpson was present.

The following matters were then discussed.

#### 1. Approval of the October 5, 2022, Commission Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Simpson made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2022, Commission Meeting. Commissioner Chattopadhyay seconded the motion. There was a roll call vote. Commissioner Chattopadhyay voted aye. Commissioner Simpson voted aye. The motion carried 2-0.

#### 2. <u>Rulemaking, Puc 1300, Utility Pole Attachments</u>

Commissioner Chattopadhyay asked Attorney Wind to update the Commission on the status of the Puc chapter 1300 Rules readoption process. Attorney Wind explained that both the Puc and En chapter 1300 rules were approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules, so the final steps in the process are for the Commission to adopt the rules and select an effective date. Attorney Wind recommended an effective date of December 1, 2022, which the Department of Energy also agreed to utilize as the effective date for the new En 1300 rules.

Commissioner Simpson made a motion to readopt with amendments the Puc 1300 rules, with an effective date of December 1, 2022. Commissioner Chattopadhyay seconded the motion. There was a roll call vote. Commissioner Chattopadhyay voted aye. Commissioner Simpson voted aye. The motion carried 2-0.
