To the Parties:

On March 24, 2021, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the abovereferenced matter. Appearances were entered by Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (Liberty), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and Commission Staff (Staff). The Commission took the petitions to intervene filed by Conservation Law Foundation (CLF) and Pipeline Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc. (PLAN) under advisement.

Following the prehearing conference, Liberty, the OCA, CLF, PLAN, and Staff met in a technical session and agreed upon the following schedule, which Staff submitted to the Commission by letter dated March 30, 2021:

The Commission has determined that the proposed schedule is in the public interest and, therefore, has approved it. For administrative efficiency, the Commission has elected to issue this secretarial letter as its prehearing order.

No objections to the CLF's and PLAN's intervention requests were filed. Accordingly, the Commission has granted CLF's and PLAN's petitions to intervene based on the standing of their members who are customers of Liberty. Although the Commission recognizes CLF's and PLAN's knowledge of gas and energy markets, infrastructure, and non-gas alternatives, as well as environmental and public health issues related to the gas industry and markets, the purpose of this proceeding is not to educate the public on any and all issues related to the broad topics of fossil fuel infrastructure and its alternatives. To ensure an orderly and focused proceeding, all parties will be limited in discovery requests, testimony, cross-examination, and legal briefings to the evaluation of Liberty's analysis and support for the proposed firm transportation agreement with Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, LLC at issue here, and the interest of Liberty customers in the prudence, justness, and reasonableness of this contract.
