Dear Ms. Gillis:

On October 5, 2016, the Commission received an application from New Energy Equity requesting Class II renewable energy certificate (REC) eligibility approval for a photovoltaic (PV) facility located at 160 Southridge Street, Springfield, VT (160 Southridge St.). The 160 Southridge St. facility is a customer-sited source as defined in the Commission's regulations at N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 2502.13.

Pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 2505.01(f), "[n]o customer-sited source shall be certified as eligible to acquire certificates under this part unless the source is located in New Hampshire." This rule implements the statutory restriction set forth in RSA 362-F:6, II. Based on these legal requirements and effective as of December 31, 2013, the Commission revoked all certifications of all customer-sited sources located outside of New Hampshire.

Accordingly, the 160 Southridge St. Facility is not eligible to obtain New Hampshire RECs. The NEPOOL Generation Information System code for the 160 Southridge St. facility is NON91444.
