Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC, d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE (FairPoint) hereby submits a revised bi-weekly stabilization report for February 7, 2011 that was originally filed in error as a confidential report on February 11, 2011. This filing corrects that issue.

For the week ending 2/4/11, there were 111 pending late orders greater than 20 days. Of those orders, 41 were held for “facility or equipment” reasons plus 21 were subsequently canceled, completed or held for customer/negotiated project commitment reasons as of the Friday “daily analysis”. The 41 orders held for “facility or equipment” reasons were distributed with 27 in Retail and 14 ASRs. The remaining records are being addressed in the daily review procedure that triages the fallout and works the orders through the systems.
