

Gaps in Broadband Availability

The Public Utilities Commission has no authority regarding broadband Internet services, for example digital subscriber line (DSL) or cable modem service.

However, we recognize that many consumers and businesses are seeking high-speed Internet access at their locations, and find that satellite broadband service does not meet their needs. We are compiling a list of areas in the state that are not served by DSL or cable modem offerings. This list will help public and private initiatives identify locations that are not yet reached.
