
**Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses**

**Procedural Order Re: Deadlines Concerning Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses**

On April 30, 2021, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) filed in the above-captioned docket a Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses, with supporting testimony, pursuant to Order No. 25,465 (February 26, 2013) and the settlement agreement approved by Order No. 23,443 (April 19, 2000). In its petition, Eversource requested the Commission to audit the costs of nine storm and pre-staging events so that the recovery of these costs could be addressed through Eversource's Major Storm Cost Reserve. No further filings have been made in this docket.

The Department of Energy shall have until January 11, 2022 to file the requested audit report or request additional time to investigate. Eversource, the Department of Energy, and any interested parties are directed to confer as to whether further process and/or a hearing will be necessary in this matter, and Eversource shall report the result to the Commission on or before January 25, 2022. If it is determined that additional process and/or a hearing is warranted, then the parties shall submit either a joint proposed procedural schedule or individual proposed procedural schedules to the Commission on or before January 25, 2022.
