Re: DW 04-048; City of Nashua—Taking of Pennichuck Water Works, Inc.

Dear Ms. Howland:

This letter follows up on the October 23, 2006 Stipulation for Conduct of View. The persons intending to participate in the view on behalf of the Pennichuck companies are: Donald L. Ware, Pennichuck Water Works President, Thomas J. Donovan, Esq., and Joseph Conner, Esq.

I note with some concern that Nashua plans to have nine persons present during the view. Nashua took advantage of a previous opportunity to inspect Pennichuck's assets over the course of two full days. The view on December 6^{th} is meant for the benefit of the Commission. Some of the stops on the view are cramped. While the pre-view dry run went smoothly, the more persons attending the view, the greater the risk of delay or mishaps. I will speak separately with Nashua's coursel about limiting its list of attendees.

Finally, the majority of the view locations lie on property of Pennichuck Water Works. Several sites are industrial type settings which require walking up and down stairs and dealing with noise and obstructions. Others are outdoors and require walking along uneven terrain. Pennichuck assumes that participants will have the ability to negotiate these conditions and will dress for the weather.
