

Subject: DG 08-045: Cost of Gas Adjustment Monthly Reconciliation, June 2008

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 24,850, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected —over/under collection for the 2008 summer period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through May and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations indicate a projected under-collection through October 31, 2008 of \$30,703 and would necessitate a \$0.1753 increase to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$2.2839, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$2.4592 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the maximum allowable rate of \$2.3664 per therm for the July 1st billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 24,850 — Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued April 23, 2008.
