NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

Petition for Increase in Rates Pennichuck Water Works

August 27, 2008
10:00 a.m.

Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) has petitioned the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of an increase to its rates. PWW has asked for an immediate increase of 11.27% and an overall increase of 25.27%. PWW's request for this increase is based on the cost to upgrade the water treatment plant and to ensure continued compliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act as well as other increased capital and operating costs. The increase would apply only to PWW's general metered rates as follows:

The Commission has scheduled a Pre-Hearing Conference to be held at the Commission's offices in Concord on August 27, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. At the Pre-Hearing Conference, the Commission will hear preliminary statements from Pennichuck and other parties, and will consider requests for formal intervenor status. The Commission will also take up the question of the schedule to govern the remainder of the case.

The Pre-Hearing Conference is open to the public. Customers and other interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and comment on the company's request.
