
NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

Petition for Increase in Rates Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire November 5, 2008 1:30 p.m.

On August 29, 2008, Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire filed a request with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission to increase its rates. Aquarion states that the higher rates, shown in the table below, are needed to help recover, among other things, investments in water utility infrastructure such as source of supply improvements and main replacements. On a temporary basis, Aquarion has requested an overall increase to its rates of 12.83%. The permanent rates proposed by Aquarion would result in an overall average increase of 21.08% in total. The typical 5/8 inch metered residential customer would see a temporary increase of 12.97% and a permanent rate increase of 18.88% in total. In addition, the Company has requested an additional increase of approximately 4.44% as a step adjustment for a significant plan addition currently under construction, proposed a change to its rate design to encourage conservation, requested a surcharge for eligible source of supply improvements, and proposed conservation measures for new developments.

N.E. Aquarium starts \$10 million expansion project

Debut slated in summer '09

BOSTON (AP) — The New England Aquarium will undergo a \$10 million renovation that includes an overhaul of the waterfront side of the facility with a marine mammal center to be completed.

Aquarium staff officials were scheduled to hold a groundbreaking ceremony on Thursday. The project is expected to take 10 months to complete with a grand opening planned for next summer. The exhibit will feature a 64,000-gallon tank as well as shallow pools and decks where

visitors will be able to meet animals face in face. The project also includes reconstruction of the entire historic glass, including an elevated and reinforced HarborWalk. And Ric, the aquarium's president, called the project an "exciting" step for one of the region's most popular tourist attractions.

James R. Courley




SERVING AS PRESIDENT OF THE SEACONAST NEWS PAPER ASSOCIATION, James R. Courley was a prominent figure in the community.
