On July 9, 2009, the Office of the Consumer Advocate filed on behalf of Aquarion Water Company, the Towns of Hampton and North Hampton, and the Commission Staff, a request for a one-day extension of time to file a settlement agreement and/or rebuttal testimony in the above referenced proceeding.
