

Dear Mr. Ozanik:

On January 5, 2009, Dunbarton Telephone Company (Dunbarton) and Cellco Partnership; New Hampshire RSA 2 Partnership; RCC Atlantic Licenses, LLC; RCC Minnesota, Inc.; and Vermont RSA Limited Partnership) (Verizon Wireless) jointly filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a negotiated Traffic Exchange Agreement (Agreement). The petition was filed for approval pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). The Agreement sets forth terms and conditions that will facilitate the provision of telecommunications service by Verizon Wireless in New Hampshire.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC §252(e)(4), the Traffic Exchange Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.

Docket No. DT 09-003 has been assigned should future filings in this matter be required.
