


Please find enclosed an original and 8 copies of two reports. First is a *revised version of* New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s (NHEC's) report of requested Customer Sited Renewable Sources aggregation for the fourth quarter of 2012 in accordance with the Commission's Aggregation approval of April 9, 2010. NHEC discovered that 2 resources were inadvertently not included in the original report. It is NHEC's intention to report this generation in the NEPOOL Generation Information System for fourth quarter 2012.

As shown in the report, the total capacity of the Class II aggregated sources is approximately **637.17** kW. NHEC requests that the Commission please update the NEPOOL GIS Administrator regarding this approved capacity.

The second report is NHEC's *revised* annual monitoring report for the calendar year 2012 in accordance with the Commission's approval of NHEC as an independent monitor.
