MODIFIED REQUEST FOR PERMANENT RATE RELIEF

PETITION TO INTERVENE

1. Intervening party:

This Petition to Intervene is submitted by Locke Lake Colony Association. Locke Lake Colony is a residential development located in Barnstead, New Hampshire consisting of 335 lots and an estimated 889 homes.

Pennichuck East Utilities will be providing water as a utility for an estimated 800 lots or homes in the Locke Lake Colony Development.

Each owner of a lot in Locke Lake Colony is a member of the Locke Lake Colony Association. Locke Lake Colony Association has the responsibility of managing the development on behalf of the members/owners, and as such, is concerned with respect to the proposed water rate increases requested by PAC and PEC.

2. Purpose of intervening:

The purpose of intervening in this matter is to object to the rate increases proposed by PAC to PEU as they pertain to those customers who own and occupy property within the Locke Lake Colony development.

This objection could apply to each of the rate increases requested.

Locke Lake Colony Association asserts in this Petition to Intervene that the rights and interests of a significant number of its members who may become customers of the PEU will be adversely affected and impacted if the petition for the rate increase is approved by the Public Utilities Commission.

3. Statement:

The rights and interests of those members of the Locke Lake Colony Association who will become customers of the PEU may be affected by this proceeding before the Public Utilities Commission for the following reasons:

a. Locke Lake Colony Association and its members will contest the Surcharge being assessed to North Country customers. Locke Lake Colony will argue these expenditures should be included in the new rate case involving Pennichuck East Utility which is currently in its test year.

- b. Locke Lake Colony Association and its members do not agree with Pennichuck East Utility in its plan to assess seasonal residents. The Association believes this method will cause an undue hardship on those customers considered to be year round. The method to charge customers using 0-3 ccf's a minimum of 4 ccf's will affect fixed income customers unfairly and unjustly.
- c. Locke Lake Colony Association, its members and contractors who may do business in Locke Lake object to the new system upgrade fee. We feel this will cause a severely detrimental financial impact on either the new customer or the contractor. To assess this cost due to its inevitable hindrance to future building projects in the Colony.

4. Owner and customer participation:

There is attached to this Petition to Intervene the signatures of many members of Locke Lake Colony Association who are also customers of PAC in support of this Petition and the objection to the proposed rate increase requested by PAC.
