

Please find enclosed for filing an original and 7 copies of CPD's Motion to Intervene and Protest in FERC Docket No. QM10-4-000 in connection with the Application of Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) filed on January 10, 2010 for Authorization to Terminate the Mandatory Power Purchase Obligation from Qualifying Facilities with Net Generating Capacity of Five Megawatts or Greater.

As noted in the attached Motion to Intervene at FERC, on numerous occasions, PSNH has represented to CPD and the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission that there is no requirement for it to enter into a long-term power purchase agreement with CPD.
