

Re: DM 09-093 TFS Energy Solutions LLC's Filing Notice of Intent to Provide Electric Aggregation Services in New Hampshire: First Deficiency Letter

Dear Mr. McDermott:

On May 13, 2009, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a notice of intent to provide electric aggregation services in New Hampshire from TFS Energy Solutions LLC (TFS). Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following item which must be addressed before TFS can be registered as an aggregator:

Puc 2003.02 (c) (5) requires a "copy of the aggregator's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state." Submittal of a copy of the webpage showing that TFS is in good standing does not satisfy this requirement. Please submit a copy of the authorization you received from that office.

Please address this discrepancy as soon as possible so that Staff may proceed with your request to register as an aggregator of electric services. Failure to respond in a timely manner may result in the Commission dismissing, without prejudice, TFS's application. Also, please be advised that you should reference the docket number, DM 09-093, in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
