Registration as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Mr. Griffin:

On September 11, 2009, Fidelity Energy Group, LLC (Fidelity Energy Group) filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with a check in the amount of \$250.00. In its application, Fidelity Energy Group indicated that it had not yet received confirmation from the New Hampshire Secretary of State that it was authorized to do business in New Hampshire. On September 15, 2009, Staff verified, through the New Hampshire Secretary of State's web page, that Fidelity Energy Group is legally registered and in "Good Standing" to do business in the State of New Hampshire.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve Fidelity Energy Group as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective September 17, 2009. This registration will expire at the end of business on September 16, 2011.


Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Fidelity Energy Group, on or before July 18, 2011. Pursuant to Puc 3003.02 (d), each natural gas aggregator shall notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. There is currently no provision in N.H.

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Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 which requires a fee for the renewal of the registration as a natural gas aggregator.

All registered Natural Gas Aggregators in the State of New Hampshire are subject to specific requirements spelled out in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Marketer Rules.
