

Dear Ms. Howland:

Please accept this letter on behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc ("Unitil" or the "Company"). In a letter dated April 30, 2010, the Company made two requests regarding funding of energy efficiency programs. First, Unitil asked for permission to transfer up to 75% of the ENERGY STAR Homes Program ("Homes") budget to the Home Performance with Energy Star ("HPwES") budget. Second, Unitil requested approval to allow single-family homes to be served using Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative ("RGGI") funds.

During the pendency of this request, several eligible projects have applied for funding from the Homes program. Therefore, the Company wishes to withdraw its proposal to transfer up to 75% of the Homes budget to the HPwES budget. Unitil notes that it has transferred 20% of the Homes budget to the HPwES program. This transfer is in accordance with the Commission's grant of authority to make discretionary transfers of up to 20% of an individual program's budget.

Please note that Unitil still seeks approval from the Commission to permit single-family homes to be served with RGGI funds via the HPwES program.
