Dear Director Howland:

Please accept this letter on behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("Unitil" or the "Company") notifying the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission that the Company has exceeded its originally proposed 2010 energy efficiency budget in the following programs: NH Home Performance with Energy Star ("HPwES") (\$38,573.46); 1 ENERGY STAR® Homes (\$47,283.78); Large C&I (\$25,354.84); and Home Energy Assistance (\$26,784.71).

New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Order Number 25,062, allows budget transfers within a sector of up to 20% of an individual program without Commission approval, so long as the Company notifies the Commission and interested parties. Within the scope of this authority, the company will make the following reallocations:
