

Dear Mr. McNeil:

On December 11, 2009, you submitted an application on behalf of Camp Merrowvista requesting certification of its photovoltaic facility (Camp Merrowvista facility) as eligible to produce Class II renewable energy certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed the application and recommended approval noting that the application was complete on December 11, 2009.

Class II eligibility requires that a facility began operation after January 1, 2006 and that it produces electricity from solar technologies. Your application indicates that Dana Doyon installed a photovoltaic facility with a gross nameplate capacity of 3.0 kilowatts at Camp Merrowvista, 147 Canaan Road, Center Tuftonboro, New Hampshire. The facility began operation on September 24, 2009, when the New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NHEC) installed the facility's revenue quality meter. The application states that NHEC will monitor the facility's output as required by N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Puc 2505.

The Commission has reviewed your application and determined that it has provided all the necessary information to demonstrate that the Camp Merrowvista facility is eligible for certification as a Class II facility. Therefore, the Commission hereby certifies that the Camp Merrowvista facility is a Class II renewable energy source effective December 11, 2009 and is eligible to be issued New Hampshire Class II renewable energy certificates. The New Hampshire Renewable Portfolio Standard certification code for the Camp Merrowvista facility is NH-II-10-025.
