Dear Mr. Fairbanks:
This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc.'s (ConEd) application to renew its registration as a competitive electric power supplier in New Hampshire pursuant to Puc 2003.01. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.01. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission will approve ConEd's application to have its registration as a competitive electric power suppler (CEPS) renewed.

Please bear in mind the following provision of Puc 2003.01 (h): "[E]ach CEPS shall re-register with the commission every 2 years on or before its original registration anniversary date by filing with the commission an application for renewal. If a CEPS fails to meet its re-filing obligation, the original registration shall expire." ConEd's original notice anniversary date was December 27, 2005 and therefore it is required to re-register on or before December 27, 2011. In addition, ConEd will also be subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
