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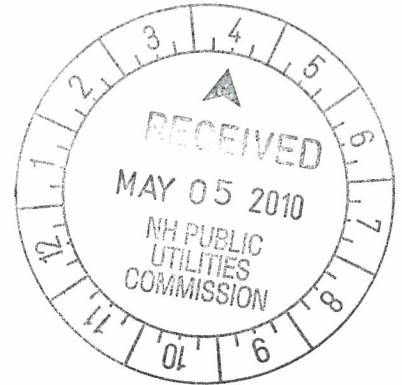

Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of National Grid NH ("Company") and the Commission staff to correct an inconsistency between the language of the temporary rate settlement agreement (filed with the Commission on April 26, 2010) and the rates set forth in Attachment A to the settlement agreement (filed with the Commission on April 29, 2010). Section III.B. of the settlement states that "The increase in rates provided for by this agreement should be implemented by increasing the existing volumetric rates for all customers on an equiproportional basis, thereby yielding the rates set forth on Attachment A." However, the rates on Attachment A show the increase being implemented by increasing both the customer charge and volumetric rates on a proportionate basis. The rates shown on Attachment A are correct, and the language in the settlement incorrectly referred to changing only the volumetric rates. This correction will be addressed by the witnesses at the hearing scheduled for May 6, but the Company and Commission staff wanted to bring it to the Commission's attention in advance in the event that the inconsistency caused any confusion.
