

Dear Director Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("Unitil"), the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Staff (Staff") and the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA") (collectively "the Parties") to advise the Commission of the status of this docket. Currently, Unitil, Staff and the OCA are engaged in settlement negotiations. The next upcoming event on the procedural schedule is the filing of rebuttal testimony by Unitil, scheduled for January 12. At this time, Staff, OCA and the Company have agreed that it would be beneficial to the settlement negotiations to postpone the filing of Unitil's rebuttal testimony, without any prejudice to Unitil's right to file such testimony should negotiations fail to produce a comprehensive settlement. If no settlement is reached, the Parties will offer a revision to the procedural schedule for the Commission's consideration to allow for the filing of rebuttal testimony prior to hearing.
