This letter is to advise the Commission that the parties have reached an agreement in principle in Docket No. DE 10-055 and are currently engaged in drafting a comprehensive settlement document. Accordingly, the parties request that the Commission amend the current procedural schedule by suspending the date for the filing of a Settlement Agreement as well as the date set for hearings on the merits. Pursuant to Puc 203.13, Unutil Energy Systems, the OCA and Staff concur in the request for postponement of the hearing and believe that postponement will promote the orderly and efficient conduct of the proceeding.
