(1) and (2)	These two adjustments for -\$937.08 and -\$1,755.32 are to correct overbilled usage due to meter reading issues. The Total of -\$2,692.40 includes 580 units billed at \$4.62 per unit plus recoupment of \$12.32 that should not have been billed and a prorated customer charge of \$0.48 billed after meter was removed. The Bill was issued in January 2009 and the adjustments were entered in January and March. The first adjustment was issued due to a coding error on a meter multiplier, the second was to abate all usage billed but 6 units as even with the multiplier adjustment the usage was overbilled.							
(3)	Wrong read on exchanged meter therefore the March 5, 2009 bill was overbilled for 279 units at \$4.62 per unit.
