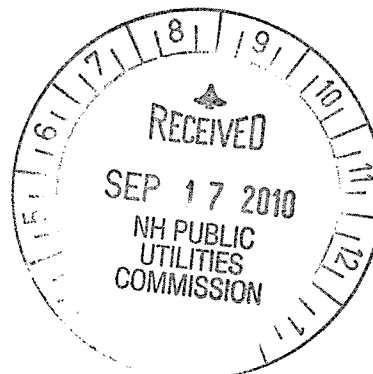

I want to respond to Docket Number DW10 091

I know this email will fall on deaf ears, but after reading the rationale the good people at Pennichuck used for their rate increase, I said to myself....wait a minute I have to get involved. I thank you, in advance, for reading my email and replying to me.

The 1st paragraph states that the rate increase "isn't related to the millions that the company has spent in its legal battle".....then.....in the fourth paragraph it states that in the company filing, "Pennichuck cited legal fees in fighting Nashua as one factor for needing more revenue. I am a Nashua resident is 1985 and there is no way that any PUC should allow a company, that is a monopoly with a guaranteed rate of return on its money in exchange for being under government oversight, to take a portion of a rate increase to fight the city that I live in.

Just because we have been using less water for three consecutive years it is not a reason to increase rates.
