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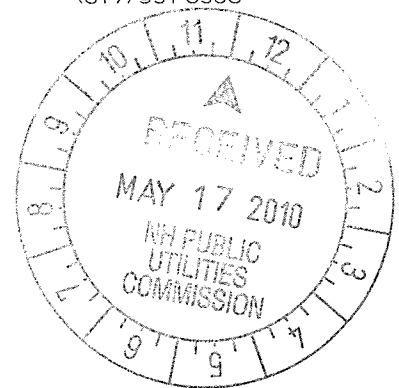

On behalf of Consumer Energy Solutions, Inc., ("CES") please find enclosed CES' Updated Registration Application for Gas Aggregator License ("Updated Application") that corrects a mistake found in CES' original filing as submitted to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") dated April 27, 2010 ("Original Application"). Please note that the attachments referenced in the Updated Application remain the same as the attachments filed in the Original Application. In particular, on May 10, 2010, PUC staff alerted the undersigned counsel for CES to an issue with respect to item #7 of CES' Original Application.
