
On May 25, 2010, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Integrus Energy Services, Inc. on behalf of Crimson Solar, LLC requesting certification for the Crimson Solar facility as a Class II source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following items that must be addressed before your application is considered complete:

- 1.) Your application does not clearly state who owns the facility. The Interconnection Service Agreement, Exhibit F to your application, names Crimson Solar, LLC as the interconnecting customer. However, the Certification of Completion Simplified Process Interconnection, Exhibit E to your application, identifies Harvard University as the interconnecting customer. Please clarify who own the facility.
- 2.) Please provide a signed affidavit by the owner of the facility attesting to the accuracy of the contents of the application. See N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.02 (b) (14).
- 3.) The letter to Crimson Solar, LLC from NSTAR, which is included in Exhibit E to your application, states that the system is 250 kilowatts. However, the New England Power Pool Generation Information System identifies the facility as having 501 kilowatts. Please explain this discrepancy.

These items must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time as your application is complete, your application will not be processed. If the requested documentation is not provided within ten business days, your file will be
