SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER OF NOTICE

On June 2, 2010, Holyoke Gas & Electric Department (HG&E) of Holyoke, Massachusetts filed an application for certification of fourteen small hydroelectric facilities as sources eligible to produce Class IV renewable energy certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F:4, the Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) law. After reviewing the application, the Commission denied certification because the HG&E system is a canal system and each facility on the system does not have installed upstream and downstream diadromous fish passages as required by RSA 362-F:4, IV. On September 10, 2010, HG&E appealed the Commission's denial, resulting in the initiation of an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2505:13.

The Commission issued an Order of Notice on October 28, 2010 which, among other things, required HG&E to publish the notice in a newspaper with general circulation in those portions of the state in which operations are conducted. HG&E published notice in the Springfield Republican, a Massachusetts newspaper. Because New Hampshire law is implicated in this proceeding, HG&E is directed to publish this notice in the Union Leader, a newspaper of general distribution in the state of New Hampshire. To allow HG&E the time to publish the notice, the prehearing conference date will be rescheduled to December 7, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby
