Renewal of Registration to Supply Competitive Electric Service in New Hampshire

Dear Mr. Lockett:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received Gexa Energy New Hampshire, LLC's application to renew its registration as a competitive electric power supplier in New Hampshire pursuant to Puc 2003.01. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.01. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission will approve Gexa Energy New Hampshire, LLC's application to have its registration as a competitive electric power suppler (CEPS) renewed.

Please bear in mind the following provision of Puc 2003.01 (h): "[E]ach CEPS shall reregister with the commission every 2 years on or before its original registration anniversary date by filing with the commission an application for renewal. If a CEPS fails to meet its re-filing obligation, the original registration shall expire." Gexa Energy New Hampshire, LLC's original notice anniversary date was **June 9, 2008** and therefore it is required to re-register on or before **June 9, 2012**. In addition, Gexa Energy New Hampshire, LLC's will also be subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
