
Please find enclosed an original and six copies of the New Hampshire Energy Trust's (the "Trust") slightly edited proposal to assume the administration of the natural gas and electric residential energy efficiency programs. The Trust, again, discovered a typographical error in its filing initially submitted on September 10, 2010, and re-submitted on September 13, 2010. Pursuant to PUC 203.10 (c), the Trust requests that the attached, corrected filing be accepted and that it replace the filings made on September 10<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.

This version of the filing is identical in all respects to the filings made on September 10, 2010, and September 13, 2010, except for the correction of the page numbering at the bottom of each page. Due to an incompatibility between two software programs being used, every page of the re-submitted filing on September 13, 2010, was numbered "Page 1 of 42." The Trust apologizes for any inconvenience that this typographical error may have caused the parties. The Trust has successfully corrected the problem, and believes that the correction of this error will assist the Commission and the parties in the discussion of the proposal offered by the Trust.

The Trust is filing this proposal in Docket DE 10-188. This cover letter and the proposal are also being filed electronically this afternoon. Copies are being sent electronically to the Service List today, also.
