The amount reflected here represents the portion related to the EAP program after the portion related to the Energy Efficiency programs has been calculated.
- (2) Pursuant to Order No. 24,329 in Docket DE 03-195 State-wide Low Income Electric Assistance Program approving the Settlement Agreement, National Grid is paying interest on the reserve balance of \$37,923.49. The interest rate, which is based on the three month London Interbank Offer Rates (LIBOR) on the first business day of the month, is 0.30344% for the month of December-10.
