Appeal of Bridgewater Power Company, L.P., Pinetree Power, Inc., Pinetree Power-Tamworth, Inc., Springfield Power LLC, DG Whitefield, LLC d/b/a Whitefield Power & Light Company, and Indeck Energy-Alexandria, LLC

Dear Ms. Fox:

Please find enclosed an original and eight copies of an RSA 541:6 notice of appeal of an administrative decision rendered by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("PUC"), along with eight copies of a related appendix and our firm check in the amount of \$205 in payment of the court's filing fee. The notice of appeal is filed by Bridgewater Power Company, L.P., Pinetree Power, Inc., Pinetree Power-Tamworth, Inc., Springfield Power LLC, DG Whitefield, LLC d/b/a Whitefield Power & Light Company, and Indeck Energy-Alexandria, LLC (collectively the "Wood-Fired IPPs"), all of whom are jointly represented by this office.

Please be aware that this is the second notice of appeal filed by appellants from PUC Docket No. DE 10-195. Because of the ambiguity of RSA 541:6 with respect to when a party to an administrative proceeding must appeal an intermediate order on rehearing, we previously filed a notice of appeal of interim orders of the PUC as a prophylactic measure. The court assigned Case Number 2011-0348 to that appeal. On June 28, 2011, the court issued an order that held further processing of Case No. 2011-0348 in abeyance pending a ruling from the PUC on a motion for rehearing filed by appellants and that directed appellants to provide the court with a copy of the PUC's order on the motion for rehearing within thirty days of the order's issuance. The PUC issued Order No. 25,239 on June 23, 2011. Order No. 25,239 is provided herewith and can be found beginning on page 137 of the enclosed appendix.

Order No. 25,239 did not moot the issues raised in Case No. 2011-0348. Because the issues raised in the two notices of appeal are substantially related and arise from the same PUC docket, the Wood-Fired IPPs request that the court merge the two appeals.
